



July 2016:

July daytime high and overnight low temperatures were above normal across the appellation. The resulting accumulated base 10 °C growing degree days were above normal for July. The growing degree day accumulation is above both 2014 and 2015 values at Vineland and Virgil. Niagara west received an average of 81 % of normal precipitation in July while Niagara East received 52 % of normal precipitation. Up to 40 mm of localized rainfall fell on July 31.

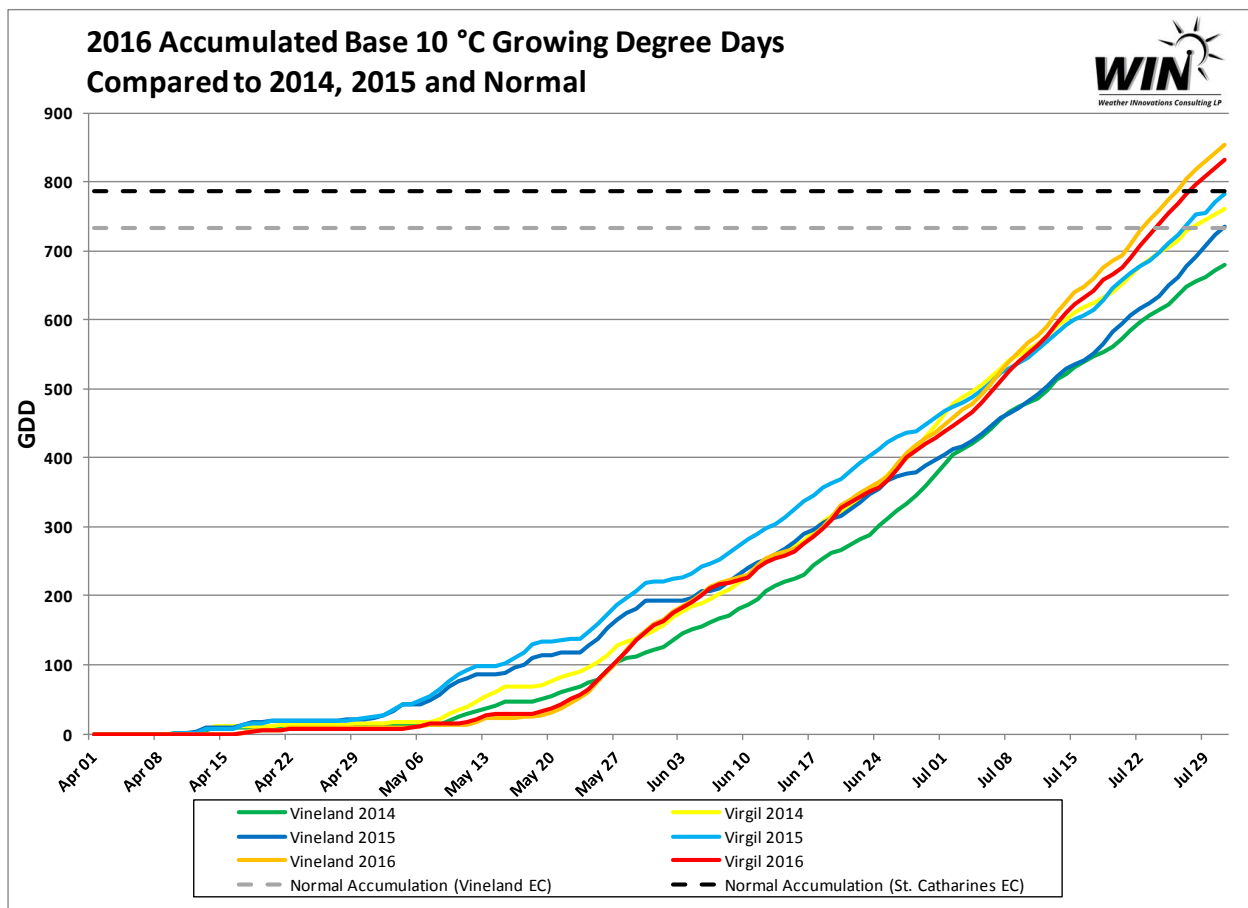


Figure 1: Growing Degree Days

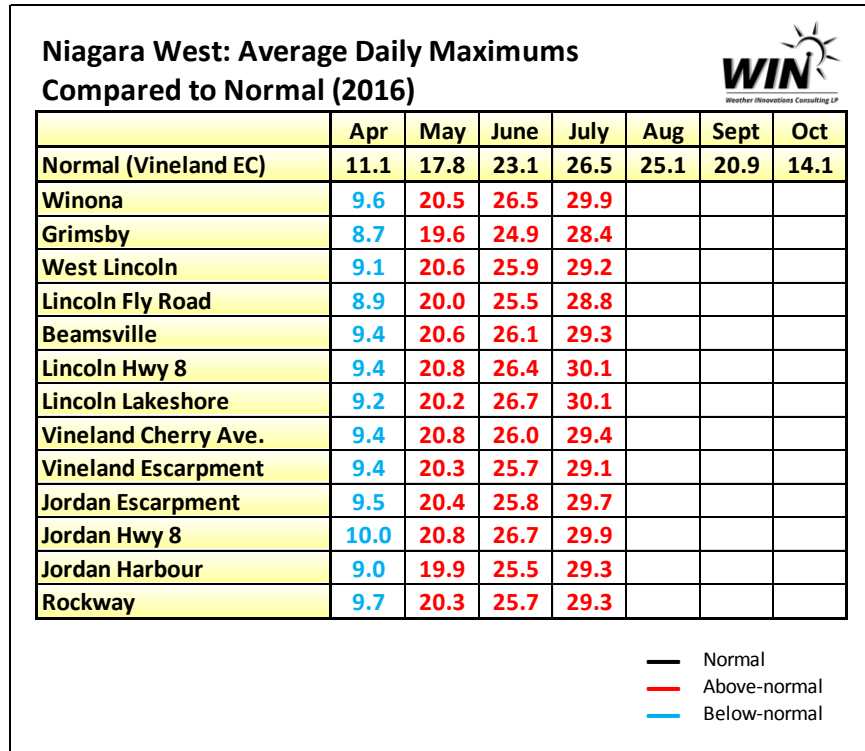


Figure 2: Niagara West - Maximum Temperatures

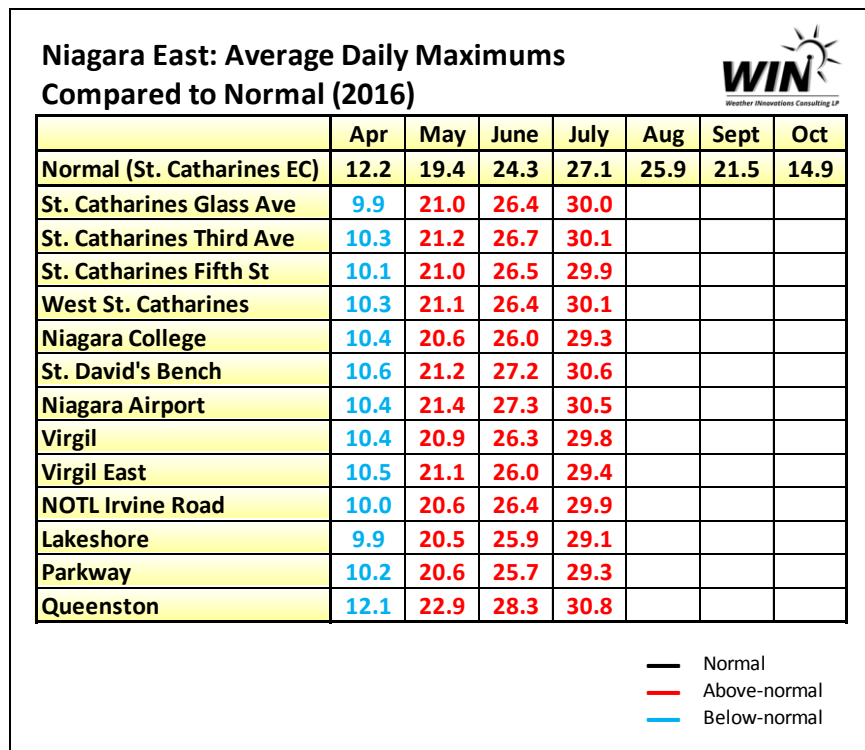


Figure 3: Niagara East - Maximum Temperatures

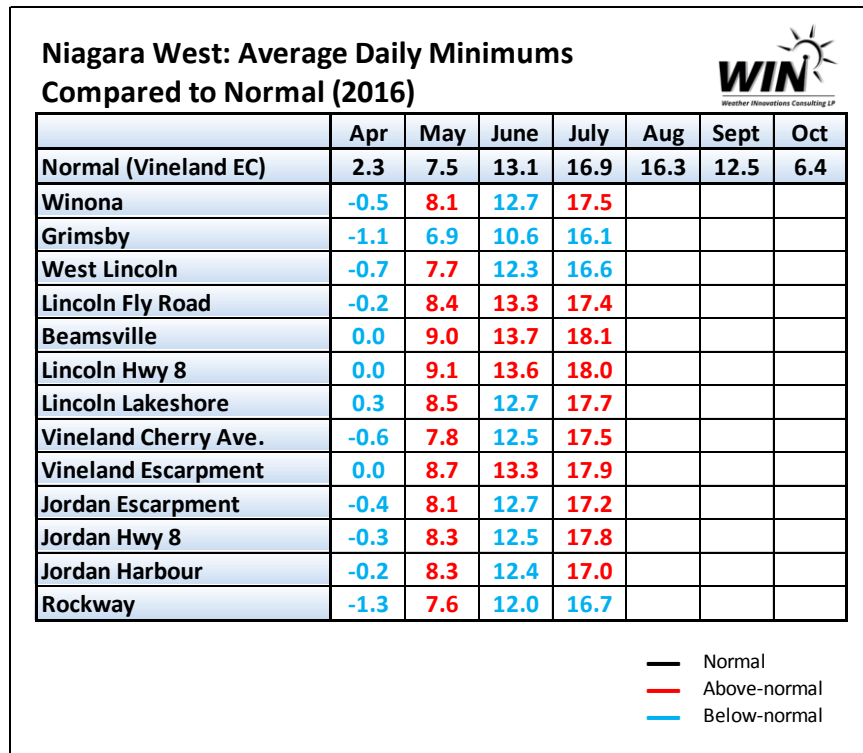


Figure 4: Niagara West - Minimum Temperatures

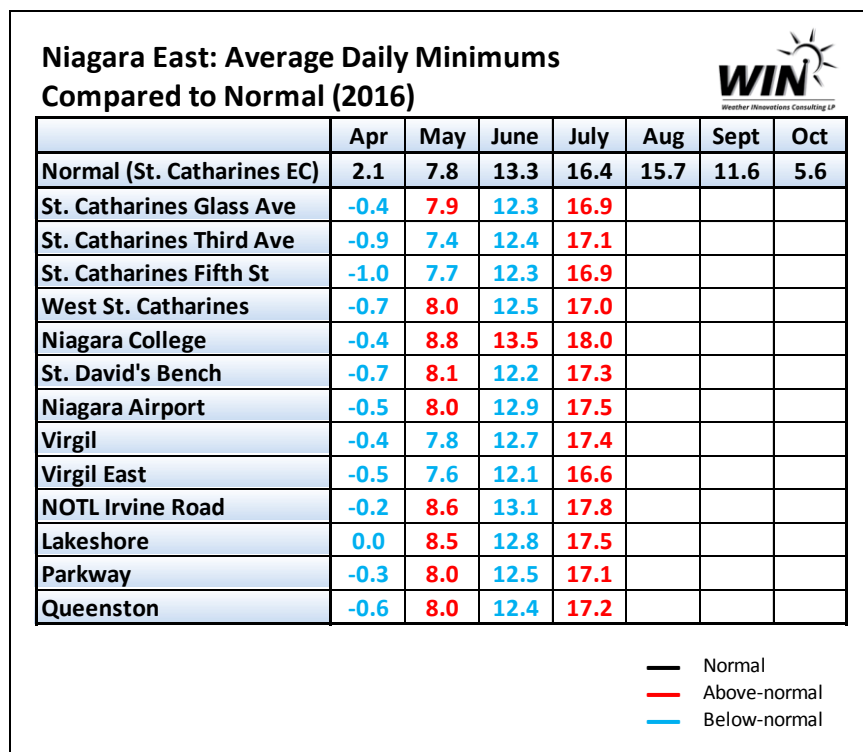


Figure 5: Niagara East - Minimum Temperatures

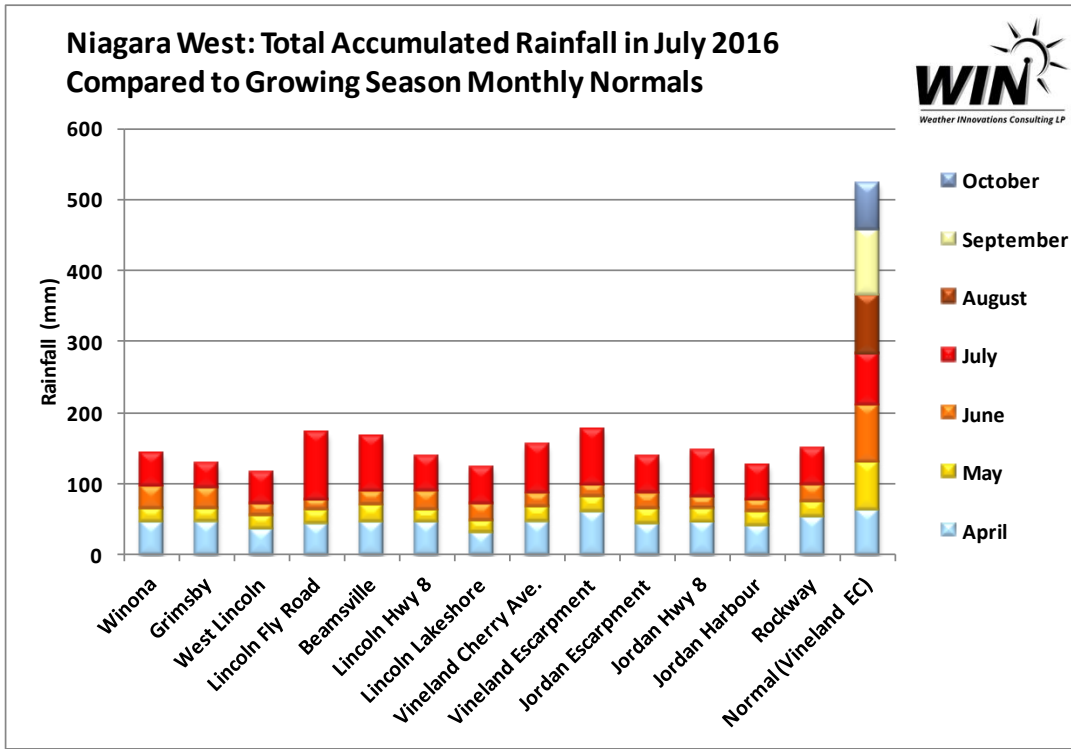


Figure 6: Niagara West – Rainfall

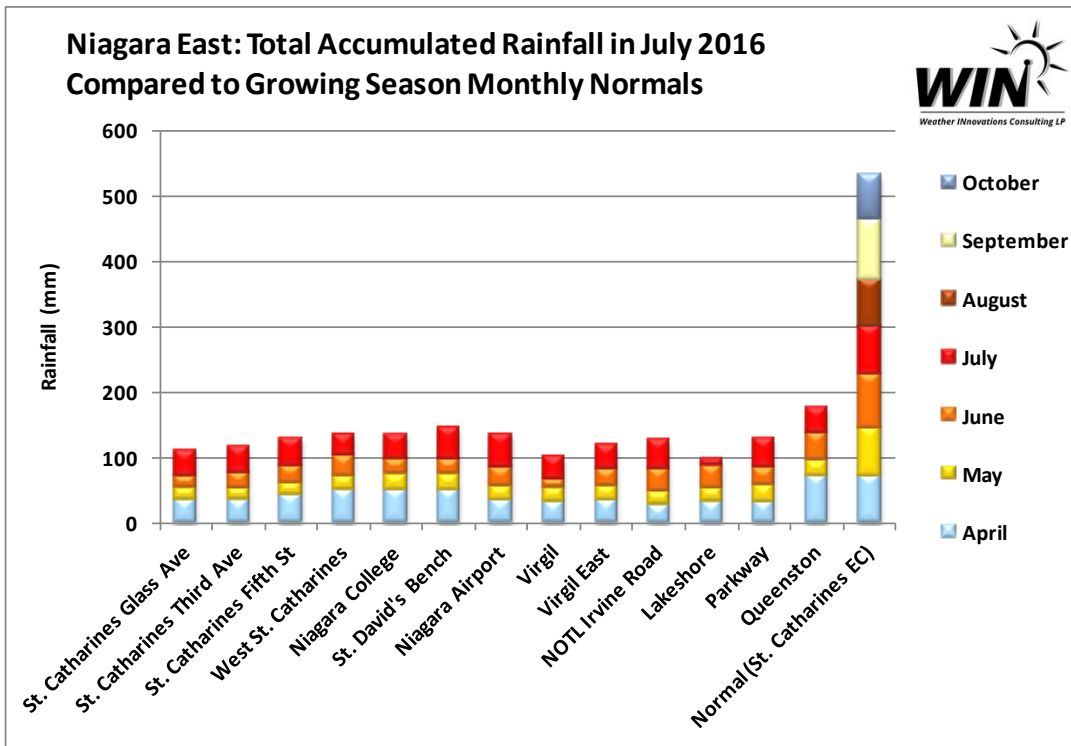


Figure 7: Niagara East - Rainfall
